Welcome back to sailing at Sugarloaf!

With the ongoing Corona virus situation, all sailing activities are subject to the guidelines defined by the Government and advice from the RYA. There is also a ban on the use of the club's water supply due to the possibility of Legionella's Disease occurring due to the lack of use during lock-down - remedial action is being taken to address this issue in the next few weeks.

The Club's Officials have been working hard to enable sailing to start again. Please can you adhere to the following:

- Until future notice, **the clubhouse will remain closed** except for the OOD. There will be **no** use of any facilities – toilets, changing rooms, showers, galley, etc.
- The club will to its best to provide an alternative place to store valuables.
- You will not be able to use any of the hoses to wash down your boat after sailing.
- You are asked to maintain a safe 2m distance from others not in your household or social bubble. There is **a limit of six people in compounds 1,2 and 3 at a time**
- Procedures for launching and recovering the safety boat in a socially distanced manner will be described by the OOD and the Beachmaster in briefings to be given prior to sailing commences. You are asked to follow their instructions to the letter and to help with this activity.
- Procedures for the use of the safety boat on the water will also be described to minimise the amount of close contact during a rescue.
- Wishing you an enjoyable and safe return to sailing
